- Authentication of data issued by the university to any party inside or outside the university.
- Measuring the performance of entities in achieving university indicators and presenting them with review panels for university decision-makers.
- Analyzing data and building evidence-based knowledge.
- Providing alternative technical solutions supported by scientific evidence to facilitate the process of taking the provision of alternative technical solutions supported by scientific evidence to facilitate the decision-making process.

- Information education for stakeholders (from policymakers, the public, the business sector, and civil society).
- Developing systems and models to support decision-making in educational, research, professional and developmental issues of interest to the university and society.
