

# RECEIVABLES DECISIONS FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT

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Nowadays most of the educational institutions are using online channels to upload their sessions.

However, the official website of Princess Nourah Bint Abdulrahman University has listed the names of faculty members yet it didn't provide any further information whether if the faculty members have private channels, whether modern or old, in which they can fill in their lectures or scientific materials and are free and open to the public, then it is believed that they actually don't have this feature.

The scholarship that is given from the Princess Nourah Bint Abdulrahman University to the students does not stop funding other students are that in need of financial support.

The internal scholarship student is exempted from tuition fees after passing the first academic year with a cumulative average of not less than (4.75) out of (5), for one semester only. However, the student must pay the fees unless she maintains the required rate for the exemption.

## Other Impact of Announcement:

To support students and motivate them to focus on their studies and do not worry about other issues concerning spending extra money inside the campuses, the scholarship is not the only offer the students receive.

For the impact enjoyed by students of the educational institution, the students all benefit from a discounted meals provided, providing adequate housing, scientific, social, cultural and training care, exchange the tickets stipulated in the financial regulations of the educational institution, provide that it has not been disbursed to it by another party, and compensate it for the value of the arrival ticket if presented at its expense, provide that the

[compensation does not exceed the value of the ticket paid to its colleagues from the same country, while the university undertakes the visa and residence services for the student.](#)

# Scholarships at Princess Nourah Bint Abdulrahman University

Saudi Arabia offers scholarships to non-Saudis to attend Saudi universities for the purposes of communicating the message of Islam, teaching Arabic, spreading science and promoting solidarity between Saudi Arabia and the world to serve humanity.

At Princess Nourah Bint Abdul Rahman University, the Grant Management Department, which is linked to the Deanship of Admissions and Administrative Registration, follows up on the implementation of the university's scholarship programs and organizes admissions processes in accordance with the regulations adopted by the Ministry of Education in Cabinet Resolution No. 94 and 1431/03/29, which regulates the admission controls of non-Saudi scholarship students in higher education institutions in the Kingdom.

## Scholarship:

It is the school seat that a non-Saudi student gets to study at Princess Nourah Bint Abdul Rahman University.

## Types of scholarships:

- External grants for non-Saudi female students from outside Saudi Arabia, and the student is a university sponsor.
- Internal grants for non-Saudi female students residing in Saudi Arabia with regular residence.

## General admission requirements for scholarships:

**The admission requirements applied to Saudi women in higher education institutions in Saudi Arabia apply to students of internal and external grants:**

- The advanced age must not be less than (17) years and not more than (25) years for the university and diplomastage.
- The applicant must have a high school diploma or itsequivalent.
- The applicant should not have received another scholarship from one of the educational institutions in the Kingdom.
- He has not been to high school for more than five years.
- To pass the advanced medical examination determined by the regulations and instructions, and be medically appropriate.

- The applicant should not be academically dismissed from an educational institution in the Kingdom.

**In addition to the above conditions, the acceptance of external grants is required to:**

1. The government of the developed country must agree to study in Saudi Arabia for countries that require it to do so for Saudi students.
2. To certify the certificates and papers of the Saudi Cultural Attaché in the developed country.
3. To prepare a case-free certificate from the security services in her country.
4. The applicant must be prohibited, in accordance with the instructions regulated, and therefore be covered by a grant, have regular residence or submit to the register of an employer in need of his services.

**In addition to the general conditions for accepting internal grants, the following are:**

1. The advanced must carry a valid regular residence.
2. The advanced must pass the general capacity test and the collection test, provided by the National Center for Measurement and Evaluation.
3. The applicant must pay after accepting the tuition fees after receiving the final admission, as instructed by the following instructions:
  - The amount (14,000) thousand riyals per year is collected at (7,000) riyals per semester in humanitarian specialties.
  - The amount (18,000) thousand riyals per year is collected at (9,000) riyals per semester in scientific disciplines.
  - The amount (10,000) thousand riyals for the year is collected at (5,000) thousand riyals per semester in the diploma of scientific specialization.
  - The amount (8000) thousand riyals for the year is collected at (4000) thousand riyals per semester in the diploma of literary specialization.

- The intern is exempted from tuition fees after passing the first school year at a cumulative rate of at least (4.75) from (5), only one semester and the student must pay the fees unless she maintains the required rate of exemption.
- The student is entitled to a refund if she wishes to withdraw according to the date of withdrawal provided that it does not exceed three weeks from the start date of the study.
- The student is not entitled to a refund if she apologizes for studying the semester one month after the beginning of the semester.
- The student does not pay tuition fees for the deferred semester provided that she does not have financial benefits for the university.
- The university has the right to suspend the student's schedule and withhold the result from her if she does not comply with the payment of the installments she owes without prior notice.
- The university must be notified if the student does not wish to complete her studies at the university.

**Documents required to submit to the study in the system of external grants:**

1. High school diploma or its equivalent with the examination of degrees certified by the Cultural Attaché of the Kingdom in the country of issuance of the certificate, translated in Arabic.
2. Certificate of good conduct, if any.
3. The passport is valid (for advanced).
4. The residence of an advanced guardian is valid.
5. Letter of approval of the developed country to study in Saudi Arabia.
6. The certificate of absence of security precedents is newly issued at least 5 months from the date of submission.
7. A medical report confirms that the applicant is healthy and issued before the application begins within a maximum of three months.
8. Bring at least two recommendations to the advanced from an accredited body in her country.

9. Establishing kinship with the applicant from the embassy of the developed country within Saudi Arabia or any official body in the developed country that includes the name of the forbidden, his residence number, the name of the applicant and the passport number, with the mention of kinship or marriage contract in case the husband is forbidden.

**Documents required to apply for the study in the internal grant system:**

1. High school diploma, and if the applicant has obtained a high school certificate from outside the Kingdom, it must be equalized through the Equations Committee of the Ministry of Education.
2. Advanced stay valid.
3. The residence of an advanced guardian is valid.
4. The advanced passport is valid.
5. A copy of the naturalization treatment document issued by the Ministry of Interior for the advanced displaced tribes.

\*The origin of the above documents must be brought after the student has accepted the match.

**Benefits for foreign grantees:**

As stipulated in the regulation of admission controls for non-Saudis in higher education institutions in Saudi Arabia and their sponsorship by cabinet resolution No. (94) and date 1431/03/29H, with no financial advantage determined by the regulation on the finance of universities, the applicant for the external grant enjoys the following benefits:

- Health care for the student throughout her studies.
- He spent a two-month bonus instead of processing when he came.
- Pay a three-month bonus instead of going out to ship books.
- The advantages enjoyed by his student counterparts in the educational institution.
- Securing reduced meals.

- Provide adequate housing, scientific, social, cultural and training care.
- The disbursement of tickets stipulated in the financial regulations of the educational institution, provided that they have not been disbursed to her by another party, and compensated for the value of the ticket if presented at its expense, provided that the compensation does not exceed the value of the ticket that is paid to her colleagues from the same country.

The university is responsible for obtaining a visa and staying for the student.

**Procedures for applying for a scholarship (external or internal) at Princess Nourah Bint Abdul Rahman University:**

1. Application is available on specific dates to be announced on the Admissions and Registration Deanship page of the University's website.
2. Submit via an electronic link that is included in the ad within the submission period.
3. Download and send the required documents via the PDF or JPEG link.
4. When the application is completed, the applicant is granted an application number, enabling her to access it for follow-up, modification and knowledge of his status.
5. After the closing of the application link, the Scholarship Department will complete the admission procedures as directed by the Ministry of Education and submit them, and admissions will be notified once and for all after the arrival of their admission directive from the Ministry of Education through e-mails and telephone calls.

**Admission criteria at Princess Nourah Bint Abdulrahman University:**

- Applications are accepted for the specialties available for the year of admission except health colleges in all its departments in accordance with the decision of the Council of Ministers No. (94) and the date of 29 March 1431, which regulates the admission controls of non-Saudi scholarship students in higher education institutions in the Kingdom.

- The admission of a non-Arabic-speaking scholarship student to the Arabic language diploma program for other women speakers, and if she wishes to complete the university stage, the requirements for the promotion of the scholarship must be fulfilled from a diploma scholarship for a bachelor's degree scholarship.
- Admission to Princess Nourah Bint AbdulRahman University for internal scholarship applicants in bachelor's programs depends on the composite ratio criterion: total grades (secondary + abilities + achievement).

Scientific Colleges	(30%) secondary + (50%) capacity + (20%) attainment
Humanitarian Colleges	(50%) Secondary + (40%) Capacity + (10%) Achievement

## Scholarship termination controls:

As stipulated in the list of admission controls for non-Saudis in higher education institutions in Saudi Arabia and their sponsorship by cabinet resolution No. (94) and date 29 March 1431:

- The foreign grant applicant must leave the Kingdom after completing her studies within three months of her completion date, and the university shall inform the passports of the end of his relationship with the grant to continue her departure.
- If the original program expires, it may not be extended by more than half.

## General provisions and alerts:

- The study system at Princess Nourah Bint AbdulRahman University in Arabic.



- Exclude any request that does not meet the required conditions and documents.
- Submitting more than one application for admission by the applicant during the same period will cancel all applications submitted to it.
- Applying for and approving the university electronically does not mean final approval, as the accepted student is notified.
- The applicant undertakes the validity of all the data and documents entered into her application and, if otherwise found, the university has the right to exclude the application.
- As stipulated in the list of admission controls for non-Saudis in higher education institutions in Saudi Arabia and their sponsorship by cabinet resolution No. (94) and date 29 March 1431:
  - The application applies to the applicant's residence regulations in the Kingdom.
  - The external scholarship student is on the university's register during the scholarship, and is responsible for it during her stay.
  - The scholarship applicant is not entitled to move from one university to another, and the university has the exception of cases that she deems appropriate.
  - The University informs the official authorities concerned in the Kingdom of grant students who have been accepted to postpone, apologize or withdraw, as well as scholarship students who have dropped out of school for any reason, in order to take what is necessary.
  - The external grant applicant is prohibited from working for companies, institutions or individuals during study.

## Scholarships

Saudi Arabia offers university scholarships for non-Saudis for the purpose of spreading Islam, learning Arabic languages, sharing knowledge, and strengthening collaboration between Saudi Arabia and international countries together to better serve humanity.

In Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University, the Scholarship Administration, at the Deanship of Admission and Registration, is responsible for executing the sponsorship programs and ensuring their adherence to the sponsorship regulations for non-Saudis issued by Ministry of Education and endorsed by the Council of Ministers' Resolution Number (94) dated 29/3/1431H- 15/03/2010 G.

### Academic Scholarship:

It is the seat granted for non-Saudi female student to study at Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University.

### Types of Academic Scholarships:

- External scholarships for non-Saudi female students from abroad. Such student shall be sponsored by Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University.
- Internal scholarships for non-Saudi students residing in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia with valid Residence Permit (Iqama).

## General Scholarship Conditions:

The Saudi students' admission conditions apply to both internal and external scholarship students, as follows:

- The age of the applicant should be minimum 17 and maximum 25 years old for both bachelor's and diploma programs.
- The applicant has a Saudi high school certificate or an equalized one.
- The applicant has not been granted any other scholarship in Saudi Arabia prior to the application.
- The high school graduation year must not exceed five years.
- The applicant must be medically fit.
- The applicant must not be academically dismissed from any other Saudi educational institution.

## Other conditions specific to internal scholarship students:

1. The applicant must hold a valid Saudi iqama.
2. The applicant must have taken the General Aptitude Test (GAT) and an Academic Achievement Test from the National Center for Assessment.
3. The applicant must pay the tuition fees after the receiving the final acceptance, as per the following:
  - A yearly amount of 14,000 SAR paid in 7000 SAR instalments per term for Humanities' majors.
  - A yearly amount of 18,000 SAR paid in 9000 SAR instalments per term for Scientific majors.

- A yearly amount of 10,000 SAR paid in 5000 SAR instalments per term for Diploma of Science majors.
- A yearly amount of 8,000 SAR paid in 4000 SAR instalments per term for Diploma of Arts majors.
- The student is exempt from instalment of one term if she passes the first year with a GPA of 4.75 out of 5. She will be required, however, to pay the remaining terms instalments if she fails to maintain her GPA.
- The student is entitled for refund in case of withdrawal during the allowed period of withdrawal (not exceeding the third week of the term).
- The student is not required to pay for postponed terms.
- The university shall pause the student's schedule and conceal her results if the instalments are not received without prior notice.
- The student must inform the university in the case of withdrawal.
- The applicant must provide an approval of scholarship from the applicant's country, for countries that require such approval from Saudi students.
- The applicant's documentation must be equalized and verified at the Saudi Cultural Bureau in the applicant's country.
- The applicant must submit a clear criminal record.
- The applicant must be accompanied by a mahram (male relative of first degree or husband) who is a scholarship student, has a valid iqama, or applies for work in Saudi Arabia.

## The Required Admission Documentation for External Scholarship Students:

1. A Saudi high school certificate or a translated, into Arabic, equalized and verified one at the Saudi Cultural Bureau in the applicant's country.
2. Certificate of good conduct, if provided.
3. The applicant's passport.
4. The mahram's valid iqama card.

5. A document of approval of scholarship from the applicant's country.
6. A clear criminal record that dates back to minimum 5 months prior to the application date.
7. A medical report confirming that the applicant is medically fit, that dates to maximum 3 months prior to the application date.
8. Two recommendation letters from an authorized establishment in her home country.
9. Proof of relationship to the mahram issued from the applicant's embassy in Saudi Arabia or any formal institution in her home country. The document must indicate the name of mahram, iqama number, name of applicant, passport number, relationship type and in case the mahram is her husband, the marriage certificate will suffice.

## The Required Admission Documentation for Internal Scholarship Students:

1. A Saudi high school certificate or an equalized one by the Ministry of Education.
2. The national iqama card of the applicant.
3. The parent's iqama card.
4. The applicant's passport.
5. A copy of the application for the Saudi Nationality issued by the Ministry of the Interior for the applicant from the displaced tribes.

\* The original documents mentioned above must be presented after acceptance.

## External Scholarship Benefits:

According to the sponsorship regulations for non-Saudis issued by Ministry of Education and endorsed by the Council of Ministers' Resolution Number (94) dated 29/3/1431H- 15/03/2010 G, all sponsorship students are granted the following benefits:

- Medical care during her scholarship period.

- An amount equal to two months stipends paid upon first entry.
- An amount equal to three months stipends paid upon graduation.
- The same benefits enjoyed by fellow students.
- Discounted meal plans.
- Housing as well as educational, social, cultural, and training care.
- Travel tickets as per the regulations, provided that no other institution issues one for her. In case the student has bought the ticket to come to Saudi Arabia, she will be reimbursed with the ticket amount provided that the amount does not exceed the ticket amount paid for other students coming from the same country.
- The university issues the iqama for the student.

### The application procedures for internal or external scholarship:

- The application submission is available during the announced application period through the university's website.
- The application is submitted online through a link provided in the announcement.
- All required documentations should be uploaded in a pdf or jpg formats.
- After a successful application submission, the applicant will be provided with an application number to follow up and edit her application.
- After the end of application period, the Deanship of Admission and Registration will send the scholarship requests to the Ministry of Education and inform the students with the application results via e-mail or calls.

### Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University's Admission Criteria:

Applications may be submitted for offered majors except for Health Colleges majors as per the decree number (94) dated 29/3/1431H- 15/03/2010 G from

- the Council of Ministers dictating the regulations for non-Saudi's scholarships in the Saudi educational institutions.
- Non-Arabic speaking students will be accepted to the Arabic Language Diploma program. In case the student desires to peruse a bachelor's degree, she must meet the scholarship upgrade criteria (from diploma to bachelor's program).
- Admission in Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University is done based on the high school accumulative percentage (a percentage of high school degree + General Aptitude Test (GAT) + an Academic Achievement Test), as per the following:

College	Percentages
Scientific College	30% on high school degree, 50% on General Aptitude Test (GAT), and 20% on Academic Achievement Test.
Humanities	50% on high school degree, 40% on General Aptitude Test (GAT), and 10% on Academic Achievement Test.
Community College	

## Scholarship End Procedures:

According to the sponsorship regulations for non-Saudis issued by Ministry of Education and endorsed by the Council of Ministers' Resolution Number (94) dated 29/3/1431H- 15/03/2010 G:

- The external scholarship student must exit the country by maximum three months of the scholarship end date. The university will inform the immigration office of the end of sponsorship.

- If the graduation requirements are not completed within the program's original period, the student may request an extension by a period no more than half of the program's period.
- Programs offered in Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman's university are in Arabic language.
- Any application that does not meet the required conditions and documents shall be excluded.
- If more than one application is submitted by the student, the student will be disqualified from all applications.
- Application submission does not guarantee acceptance.
- The applicant confirms the accuracy of the information provided in the application. If proven otherwise, the acceptance will be cancelled.
- According to the sponsorship regulations for non-Saudis issued by Ministry of Education and endorsed by the Council of Ministers' Resolution Number (94) dated 29/3/1431H- 15/03/2010 G, the following applies:
  - Immigration regulations are applied to scholarship students.
  - External scholarship students are sponsored by the university during the scholarship period.
  - Transfer between universities for scholarship students is not permitted unless an exception is deemed possible by the university.
  - The university alerts the designated officials when a scholarship student postpones, withdraws from a term, withdraws from the university, or discontinues studies.
  - Scholarship students are not permitted to work for individuals or organizations during their scholarship period.

- Health care for the student throughout her studies.
- He paid a two-month bonus for processing supplies upon his arrival.

- Spending a reward of three months in allowance for graduation to ship books.
- Advantages enjoyed by fellow students of the educational institution.
- Discounted meals provided.
- Providing adequate housing, scientific, social, cultural and training care.
- Exchange the tickets stipulated in the financial regulations of the educational institution, provided that it has not been disbursed to it by another party, and compensate it for the value of the arrival ticket if presented at its expense, provided that the compensation does not exceed the value of the ticket paid to its colleagues from the same country.
- The university undertakes the service of issuing the visa and residence for the student.

## Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University conditions:

- That the age of the applicant is not less than (17) years and not more than (25) years for the undergraduate and diploma levels.
- The applicant must have a high school diploma or its equivalent.
- The applicant must not have obtained another scholarship from an educational institution in the Kingdom.
- The high school diploma should not be more than five years old.
- The applicant must pass the medical examination determined by the regulations and instructions, and be medically fit.
- The applicant must not be academically dismissed from one of the educational institutions in the Kingdom.
- That the government of the applicant's country approves the study in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia for countries that require this for Saudi students.
- The certificates and identity papers must be attested by the Saudi Cultural Attaché in the country of the applicant.
- The applicant must present a free-of-precedent certificate from the security services in her country.

- That the applicant has a mahram, according to the instructions regulating this, provided that he is covered by a grant, has a regular residence, or is on the register of an employer in need of his services.

## General admission requirements Princess Nourah University Scholarships:

### **Admission requirements that apply to Saudi women in higher education institutions in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia apply to students of internal and external scholarships:**

- Be developed holds a general secondary school certificate or its equivalent .
- Not to be developed has got another scholarship from one of the educational institutions in the Kingdom.
- It should not have been on a high school diploma more than five years.

The applicant must pass the medical examination determined by the regulations and instructions, and be medically fit.

- Not be separated academically advanced from one of the educational institutions in the Kingdom.
