Princess Nourah Bint Abdulrahman University -PNU provides state-ofthe-art educational facilities to nearly 60,000 students. Nearly all of the campus is registered with the U.S. Green Building Council's Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) program, with four LEED Gold buildings. Professionals from multiple offices in the United States and the Middle East collaborated on the program, which included 15 colleges in the arts and sciences. Facilities included a medical center, a research center, a K-12 building, sports and recreation buildings, residences, and a 700-bed, full-service hospital. <u>PNU is considerate on of the biggest women's universities in the world in terms of its sports facilities</u>.



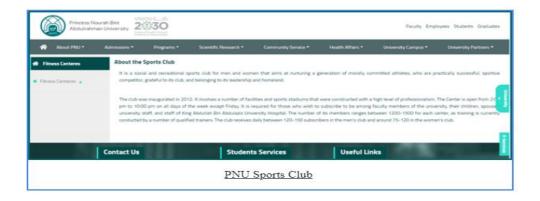
Memorandum of cooperation to activate sports facilities

PNU Sports Club

<u>PNU Sports Club</u> is a space to propitiate activities, outreach programs, and projects in the local community related to sports, exercise health, and wellbeing. It is a social and recreational sports club for men and women that aims at nurturing a generation of morally committed

athletes, who are practically successful, sportive competitor, grateful to its club, and belonging to its leadership and homeland.

The club was inaugurated in 2012. It involves a number of facilities and sports stadiums that were constructed with a high level of professionalism. The Center is open from 2:00 pm to 10:00 pm on all days of the week except Friday. It is required for those who wish to subscribe to be among faculty members of the university, their children, spouses, university staff, and staff of King Abdullah Bin Abdulaziz University Hospital. The number of its members ranges between 1200- 1500 for each center, as training is currently conducted by a number of qualified trainers. The club receives daily between 120- 150 subscribers in the men's club and around 75-120 in the women's club.



Sports Club Vision, Mission and Goals

Vision

The sports centers should be a meeting place for staff, members, employees, and faculty members of this precious university campus, which includes the elite of this giving country. The sports centers shall nurture children at a high level in all respects (social, sporting, and cultural) all in line with the Kingdom's Vision 2030.

Mission

To nurture a generation of morally committed athletes, who are practically successful, sportive competitor, grateful to its club, and

belonging to its leadership and homeland by providing the necessary financial resources to support our sports, social, educational, and psychological programs, qualifying human resources technically and administratively, developing the administrative aspects of the club and achieving a distinguished community partnership. Sports club has defined in two of its objectives (2 and 7) contributions for the community to enjoy health and well-being. All objectives are shown below:

- 1. Achieve ethical and behavioral commitment at the level of the members of the sports club at the university
- 2. Create a community partnership with other sports, economic, social, educational and media institutions
- 3. Develop the administrative environment and working methods (emanagement)
- 4. Develop infrastructure (football pitch that is naturally cultivated).
- 5. Develop the technical and administrative skills of the club's staff, including coaches, players and executives
- 6. Achieve financial self-sufficiency for the regular club expenses.
- 7. Participate in social, national and sports events at the level of the Kingdom.

Strategic Objectives of the Sports and Recreational Center

- Encourage members to subscribe and participate in sports and recreational activities at the Center.
- Raise the level of physical fitness of members through various training programs.
- Perform sports activity regularly and continuously to prevent many diseases, including obesity.
- Encourage children to exercise sports to prevent diseases.
- Build good social relations between members through sports and recreational activities, as well as social celebrations and various festivals.
- Help members benefit from all sections of the sports center of sauna – steam – swimming pool – football – squash – tennis – basketball – volleyball – etc.
- Train members on the basic skills of each game and provide an overview of the rules of games so that

members can practice various games correctly and Interestingly

Encourage members to invest their leisure time in the exercise of sports activity.

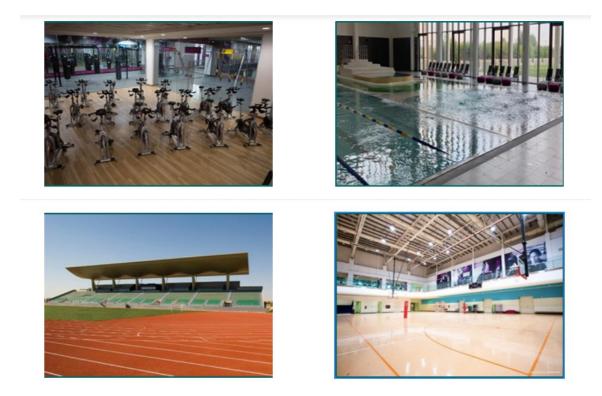
Sporting Activities and Events

PNU, sports authority sign deal to promote women's sport in Saudi Arabia

The General Authority for sports and PNU signed a memorandum of cooperation to activate sports facilities with a view to promoting healthy lifestyles. The pact was signed in the presence of princess Reema bin Vandar of the General Authority for sports and PNU rector. Signing this agreement with PNU, which is considered one of the biggest women's universities in the world in terms of its sports facilities will contribute to boosting students ' involvement in sports and making them aware of its importance for their bodies. The agreement forms part of a project of general authority for sports and the Saudi Arabian Olympic Committee to raise the scale of community participation in sports from 13 percent to 40 percent by the year 2030 as a part of vision 2030. This memorandum embodies cooperation between government agencies to contribute to spreading awareness of the importance of sports for the Saudi community. With this memorandum, it is expected that the community is in crucial need of spreading and promoting a sports culture.

The signing of a memorandum of understanding between the Jamah Alomirh Norh Arabia Union for the Special Olympics, where the University Chancellor His Excellency the President of the Girl University D.dnaa Abdulaziz Faraj is represented The Saudi Federation of Special Olympics was represented by the Executive Director, Dr. Heidi Al-Askari, at the university headquarters. The aim of the memorandum is to achieve fruitful cooperation between the special Jamah Alomirh Norh for the implementation of the Olympic programs of the Union of Saudi Arabia and the activities of the special Olympic Games to help children and adults with intellectual disabilities, providing them with continuous opportunities to improve their physical condition and activating the role of the parties in achieving Vision 2030.

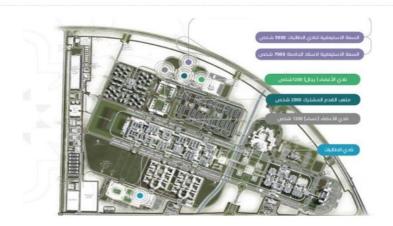
