





Princess Nourah Bint AbdulRahman University concluded a memorandum of understanding with the General Foundation for Technical and Vocational Training, in the presence of His Excellency the President of Princess Nourah University,Dr. Inas Bint Suleiman al-Issa, and His Excellency the Governor of the General Foundation for Technical and Vocational Training, Dr. Ahmed bin Fahd Al Fahid, on Tuesday, July 13, 2021, at the University's headquarters.

The memorandum aims to activate the role of education and training policies in the Kingdom in developing the mechanism of transformation and bridging between the Technical College and the University, creating a budget in academic and technical disciplines that meet the needs of the labor market, and exchanging experiences from manpower between the two parties.

The areas of cooperation between the two parties were the sharing of expertise in professional programs and educational and training bags, the development of a transfer and bridging programme and the development of "Sigma" programmes for female students and trainees between technical colleges and the university.

The memorandum included benefiting from the experiences of the members of the Training and Teaching Authority between the two parties, exchanging training courses in specialized fields, as well as cooperation in the fields of research, scientific studies and participation of results to serve both parties, as well as providing the opportunity for practical and cooperative training in accordance with the possibilities available, in addition to cooperation in the field of talent and innovation.

This memorandum comes from the guidance of the good leadership in the cooperation of educational and training institutions in the Kingdom and support the policies of integration between them, cooperation and activation of the role of education and training policies in the Kingdom, and the exchange of scientific and practical experiences that serve both parties.

On Sunday, The Dean of Community Service and Continuing Education at Princess Nourah Bint AbdulRahman University launched a professional training program for hair beauty and care, in partnership with L'Oréal Saudi Arabia, where the program trains and qualifies girls as experts in hair beauty and care, contributing to the kingdom's vision 2030. By empowering Saudi women in the professional field, supporting them in the establishment and development of SMALL and medium-sized businesses, giving them the opportunity to redraw their careers and inspire opportunities through education and training, while registration in the program continues until Saturday, 23 January 2021.

The program includes eight comprehensive training units, in a systematic format organized for six months, at the training headquarters in the deanship of community service and continuing education, one-month field training in local salons, dividing the course into (400) hours of theoretical and applied lessons in changing the color of hair, cutting, styling and salon development, in addition to (112) hours of applied training in an independent salon to gain the best experience in this field.

Dr. Latifa Bint Hamad Al Farian, Dean of Community Service and Continuing Education, explained that, based on the role of dean of community service and continuing education to empower Saudi women, and increase their contribution to the labour market, we have developed a training program for hair beauty and care in collaboration with a global company specializing in beauty products and services, with the aim of providing Saudi girls with the skills needed for future jobs and providing new jobs, allowing them to set up professional projects to contribute to sustainable community development, in order to achieve the aspirations of saudi girls. The wise leadership directives aimed at raising the social capital index and increasing women's participation in the labour market from 22% to 30% according to The Kingdom's Vision 2030.

Princess Nourah University implements various scientific and technical programs

Based on the strategic directions of Princess Nourah Bint Abdul Rahman University, which emphasizes that the University will contribute to providing competitive outcomes, to participate effectively in the overall development process, the University organizes through its colleges many courses and programs aimed at enriching knowledge scientifically and technically, where the Faculty of Computer Science and Information held a package of workshops and lectures during the first semester of the academic year 1442 Ah, starting with the introductory meeting of new students in the week "Lighthouse Nourah" to introduce student and community services provided by The university and the college, in the presence of the dean of the college and its agents and heads of departments, and with the participation of the psychological and social guidance unit to introduce the unit's services to new students. The Faculty of Computer Science and Information through the Quality and Development Agency and the Research Center contributed to the organization of a number of technical and research lectures, and the Community Service Unit participated in a number of courses inside and outside the university, aimed at raising awareness of modern technology, including a series of virtual digital courses within the cooperation between the Faculty of Computer Science and Information and the Center for Education west of Riyadh as part of the initiative (Compu Tec), as well as a series of digital lectures in cooperation with the Digital Giving Initiative supported by the Ministry of Communications And information technology.

In the same vein, the Department of Computer Science at the Faculty of Computer Science and Information conducted a training course on how to create a special website for female students of the Faculty of Science, and a workshop entitled "Preparing and implementing tests using Microsoft Times and Microsoft Formats".

On the other hand, the Faculty of Engineering organized the Linux Essential course in collaboration with the Cisco Academy with the participation of 32 students and a group of faculty members, and carried out an organized course from IEOM-CEN with the participation of (18) female students.

Princess Nourah Bint Abdulrahman University seeks to provide its employees with the skills needed for future jobs that are changing with technical, economic, cultural and social influences that enable them to compete in the labour market.

With the aim of preparing female students and graduates professionally, the Student and Vocational Support Center at Princess Nourah University offers a package of training courses

The Student and Vocational Support Center at Princess Nourah Bint AbdulRahman University organized a training course entitled "Job Search Strategies", presented by the faculty member of the Faculty of Education, Professor Dalal Al-Aweidi. The course targeted female university students and graduates, with about 90 female trainees and graduates.

On the other hand, the professional guide and director of the Department of Vocational Guidance, Professor Fatima Al-Alola, presented a training course entitled "Preparing a cv" targeting students and graduates of the Faculty of Design and Arts. In addition to managing the group vocational guidance session entitled "Professional Values" for female students and graduates.

The Student and Vocational Support Center provides a weekly individual vocational guidance session service for female students and graduates with a

specialized professional guide to advise them, and allows them to receive job offers from several quarters.

It is worth mentioning that Princess Nourah Bint AbdulRahman University established the center to provide vocational guidance services, job support and training programs for female students and graduates, in addition to keeping up with the effective and continuous acceleration in the pace of innovation and its role as a women's educational edifice in achieving alignment and response to the future workforce, by increasing its ability to pair with technical acceleration on the one hand and sustaining the learning process, responding to the labor market and integrating into the work environment on the other.

Princess Nourah University receives accreditation for advance HE professional development program

Princess Nourah Bint Abdul Rahman University has been accredited to a professional development program that will award the university's faculty members a teaching and learning fellowship by the British Academy of Higher Education (Advance HE), the first university in the Kingdom to receive this accreditation.

Over the past three years, Princess Nourah Bint AbdulRahman University has led the team at the Center of Excellence in Teaching and Learning, which is under the umbrella of the Deanship of Academic Development to obtain this accreditation, to equip an empowered team of 83 fellows at the university. These fellowships were obtained through direct and individual submission to the British Academy of Higher Education and support for the Centre of Excellence in Teaching and Learning. As a result, a number of fellow faculty members have interacted with the UKPSF, the main basis of the fellowship and accredited programmes.

With this accreditation, Princess Nourah Bint Abdulrahman University will be able to award fellowships to members who have successfully completed the accredited "Academic Excellence" program, which will contribute to improving teaching and learning practices and celebrating their importance, as well as enabling members to receive professional recognition for their successful professional practices.
