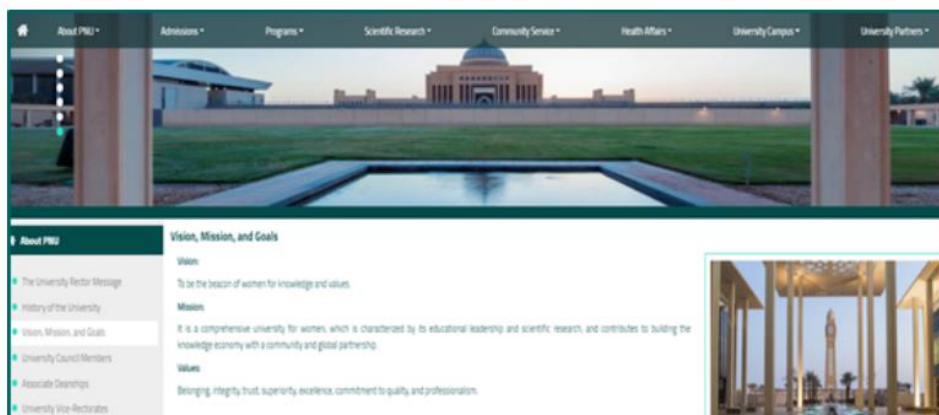


ENCOURAGE APPLICATIONS BY WOMEN UNDERREPRESENTED

Moreover, as part of the Kingdom's strategic Vision 2030, women have been set a comprehensive goal for increasing their contribution to the labour market, retaining her rights in the health and education sectors, in unison with the fifth goal of the sustainable development goals. Thus, among the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's initiatives in partnership with PNU for promoting gender equality and women empowerment, there are several points to highlight. 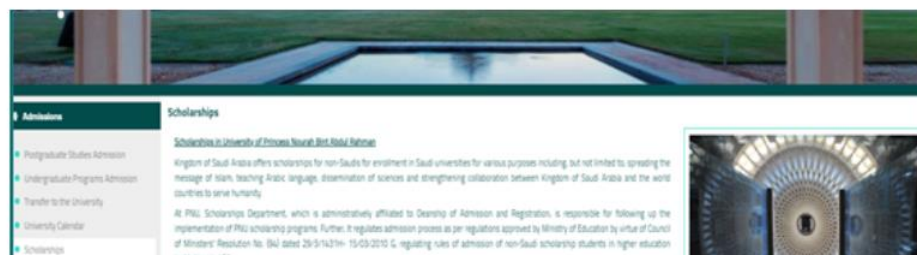
PNU Mission

Over the past twenty years, Saudi women's access to education has increased dramatically. The Saudi Government has spent billions of dollars to improve women's education. This includes money spent to improve campuses, create better research programs, and establish more university programs, such as computer science and law, for female students in order to integrate them into the workforce. The development of Princess Noura University, an institution dedicated to women's education, was a five-billion-dollar investment. The campus includes an administration building, a central library, conference centers, buildings for

fifteen academic faculties, several laboratories, and a 700-bed hospital equipped with state-of-the-art facilities.

The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia offers scholarships for non-Saudis for enrollment in Saudi universities for various purposes including, but not limited to, spreading the message of Islam, teaching Arabic language, dissemination of sciences and strengthening collaboration between Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the world countries to serve humanity.

At PNU, Scholarships Department, which is administratively affiliated to Deanship of Admission and Registration, is responsible for following up the implementation of PNU scholarship programs. Further, it regulates the admission process as per regulations approved by Ministry of Education by virtue of Council of Ministers' Resolution No. (94) dated 29/3/1431H- 15/03/2010 G, regulating rules of admission of non-Saudi scholarship students in higher education institutions in KSA.



Scholarships

In its efforts to empower women in fields in which they are under-represented, create new opportunities for women in the labor market, and develop women's skills and capabilities and increase their participation in fields that achieve the Kingdom's vision 2030, PNU has announced the launching of 21 new programs in the fields of computer and information science, digital journalism, tourism, filmmaking and animation, and more that provide students with the necessary skills and knowledge in order to meet the needs of the labor market.

In response to the national plan to localize jobs and open new fields that keep pace with the need of the labor market, and through its academic plan, Princess Noura bint Abdulrahman University creates (21) specialized programs for the bachelor's and diploma stages in (10) colleges as part of its programs for the academic year 1442 AH

The newly developed programs are represented in the College of Computer and Information Sciences offering 3 specialized programs in (Artificial Intelligence Sciences), (Data Science and Analysis), (Cyber Security), and the College of Business and Administration also offers 3 Bachelor programs (Financial Economics) and (Human Resources Management), in addition to the (Marketing) program

While the College of Arts offers the (Digital Journalism) program and the (Tourist Guidance) program, in addition to the (Museums and Antiquities) program, the College of Design and Art also offers the (Photography) program, the (Filmmaking and Animation) program, and the Respiratory Therapy program from College of Health and Rehabilitation Sciences

The College of Engineering creates a program in (Biomedical Engineering), in addition to the College of Languages that offers a program in (Chinese Language) and the College of Nursing that offers the (Midwifery) program, and the College of Science offers a specialization in (Medical Physics)

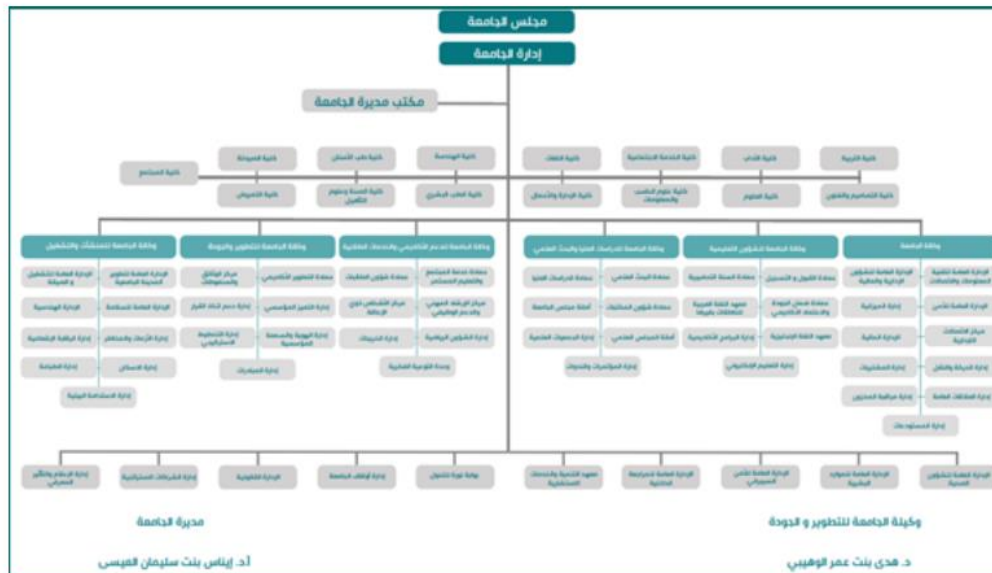
Launching of 21 new programs

PNU has also launched a Higher Diploma program in Physical Education for Girls with the aim to prepare qualified cadres to find new job opportunities in the field of sports. It also established a new department, the Department of Sports Affairs, in order to utilize its sports facilities and create a sporting environment where female students are provided with the necessary knowledge and training in various sports disciplines and be able to participate in regional and international sporting events. It also aims at raising the level of community awareness about the importance of Saudi women's practice of sports and adopting a healthy lifestyle. 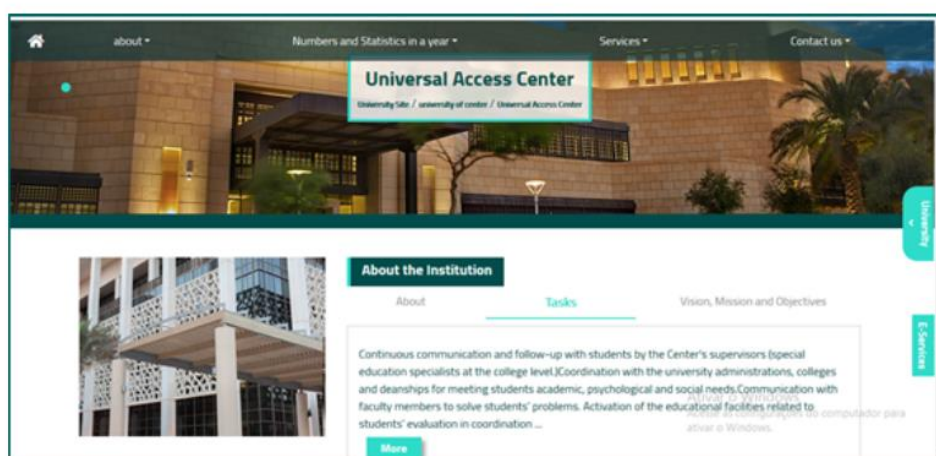
In regards to the proportion of women in senior positions at PNU, the attached organizational structure demonstrates the different senior positions at the university which are predominantly occupied by female employees.

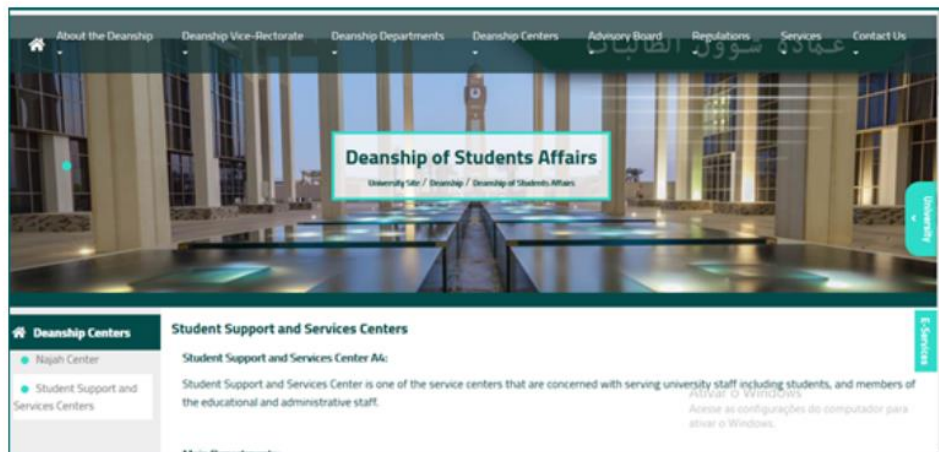
