Program Contents (Program Description)

The program aims to enable learners to communicate effectively in the Arabic language. It focuses on teaching the communicative skills of the Arabic language (reading, listening, speaking and writing), according to the international frameworks for teaching languages. The levels range from the lowest beginner level to the upper intermediate level as shown in the following:

1. Level 1 (lower beginner): (score from 0–10 on the placement test):

This level introduces the basic skills for the beginner learner, such as: introducing oneself, exchanging greetings, expressions of kindness and courtesy, and asking permission skills. At the end of this level, she will receive a certificate for passing the lower beginner level.

2. The second level (intermediate beginner): (score from 11–20 on the placement test):

The learner will be able to acquire the basics of communication with others in language situations that meet her communication needs in the Arab environment. At the end of this level, he will receive a certificate of passing the intermediate beginner level.

3. The third level (upper beginner): (score from 21–30 on the placement test):

The learner will be able to understand and participate in short language dialogue skills. She will also be trained to read and write short paragraphs about daily events, extend and accept invitations to others, and identify places and information contained in banners and advertisements. At the end of this level, she will receive a certificate of passing the upper beginner level.

4. The fourth level (lower average): (score from 31-40 on the placement test)

The learner will be able to start a coherent general dialogue, participate in talking about social topics, provide information on very familiar topics, such as hobbies and interests, and use some cultural phrases on occasion. By the end of this level, she will receive a certificate of passing the lower intermediate level.

5. Level 5 (Intermediate Intermediate): (score from 41-50 on the placement test)

The learner will be able to understand dialogues and intermediate-level topics, participate in real dialogues and engage in simple discussions, formal writing, and request service and assistance from others. At the end of this level, she will receive a certificate for passing the Intermediate level.

6. Sixth Level (Upper Average): (Score of 51 and above in the placement test)

The learner will be able to understand long dialogues and various topics in society, participate in real dialogues, engage in discussions, and express opinions. At the end of this level, she will receive a certificate of passing the upper intermediate level.

- Learners acquire the Arabic language within the context of Arab and Saudi culture.
- The program provides the opportunity for learners to immerse themselves in the language in the Saudi environment through the extra-curricular activities it provides and visits, systematic excursions to practice the language, such as visiting popular markets, restaurants, Saudi families and the most famous places in Saudi Arabia...
