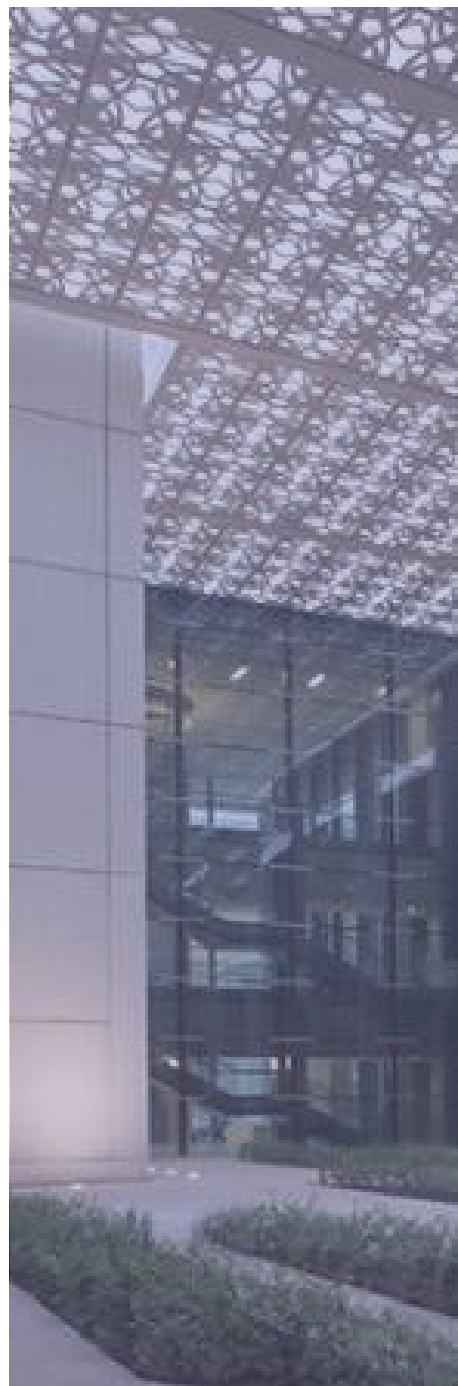

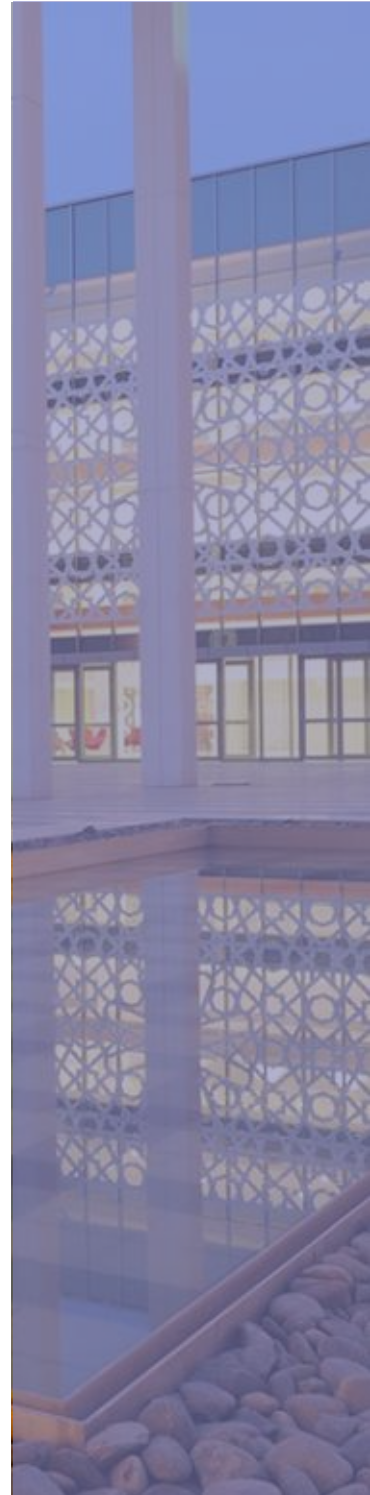
# Interdisciplinary Program

It was offered as a free scholarship for the first class that joined the program as part of the integration of national efforts to serve all beneficiary groups in the state sectors. It was launched in conjunction with the selection of Riyadh as the capital of Arab Women 2020.



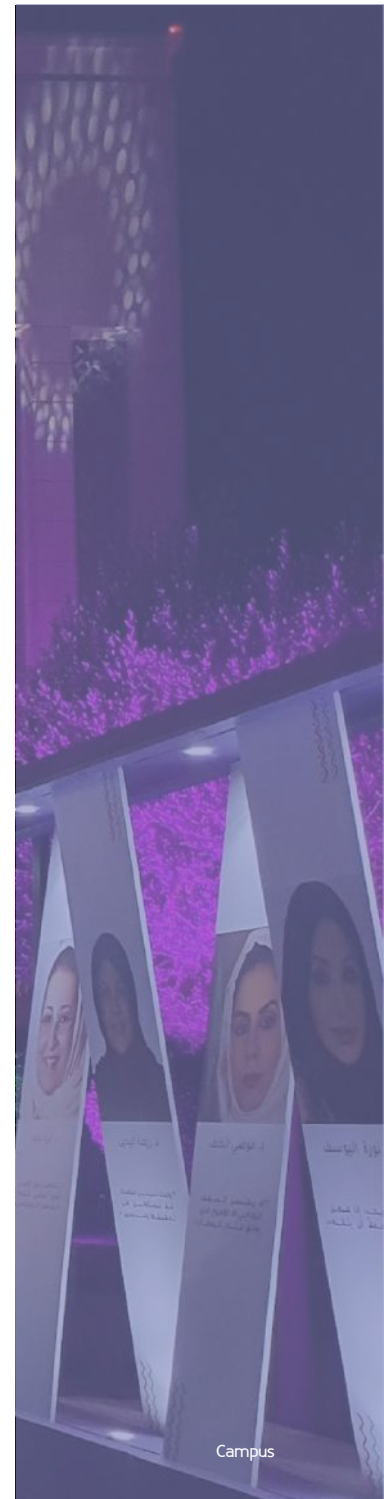

Masters of Women's Studies is a program that is the first of its kind in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, aiming to qualify female leaders to participate in national development and achieve the goals of the vision by raising the percentage of women's participation in the labor market and enabling them to participate in national development in all fields.

The HE Advance Foundation in the United Kingdom, which is specialized in the field of higher education, supported the establishment of the program and its presentation with the latest teaching and assessment strategies in this field, by university faculty members from various disciplines and scientific backgrounds in business administration, law, social service, literature and education, giving the program a comprehensive three-dimensional image for the study of women's topics in science and various fields.

The nature of the program does not require the extension of a specific specialization at the bachelor's level, and it is presented to serve the academic and professional scientific fields and sectors with a flexible model that achieves the advantage of meeting influential future leaders and provides a variety of networking opportunities.

The program follows a distinguished and new model in its Implementation of different exit points with accredited qualifications: a higher certificate in leadership and women's studies, a higher diploma in women's studies, a master's in women's studies.

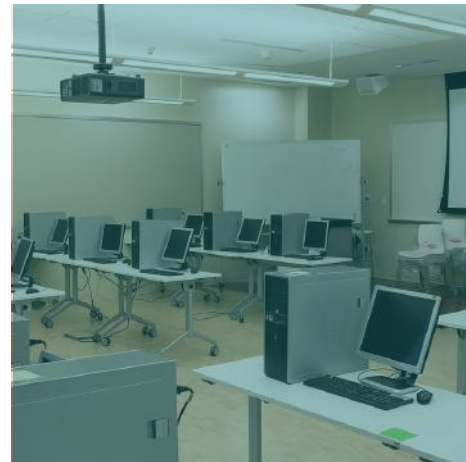

# Science Programs

The university offers a number of graduate programs in scientific specializations offered by the College of Science, the College of Computer and Information Sciences, and the College of Business and Administration. Some programs are offered in local and global partnerships with specialized academic or professional bodies, which give students the opportunity to obtain global scientific and research experiences within a local environment. These programs are supported by the university's available infrastructure, services, support facilities, and competitive advantages that the university possesses in the field of scientific specializations.

The Health Sciences Research Center provides opportunities for scientific research for university employees and researchers from postgraduate students and collaborating bodies. The center includes 30 laboratories, including 18 laboratories in basic sciences, Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Biology laboratories are distinguished by the presence of a tissue culture room for each laboratory, which makes them unique in the world. The center also includes a specialized database and 20 animal incubators with all their requirements, including operating rooms, sterilization, and so on. The center provides research laboratories services through the use of the latest equipment and advanced analytical methods, and services include various disciplines such as genomics, biotechnology and analytical chemistry.

The university has a solar field that contains 3600 solar panels with an annual energy production capacity of 28 million kilowatts, and this field is considered the largest water heating system in the Kingdom. This field is considered a model for adapting and investing local strengths, To create a more diversified and sustainable economy, various scientific and research programs support opportunities and areas of renewable energy innovation.

The College of Science, under the supervision of the Department of Plant Herbarium Biology, which has been registered on the lists of the World Botanic Garden in New York NYBG with the international symbol (PNUH) as the seventh local herbarium recorded globally, as a long-term investment to document and preserve of plant species and the preservation of the Flora of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. In line with the Kingdom's strategies and its future plan 2030 towards the environment and the restoration of vegetation, and the preservation of wild plants and their seeds, especially the economic, rare and endangered ones that are edible, medicinal, pastoral, aromatic and toxic. The herbarium contributes to the enrichment of scientific research.

The College of Computer and Information Sciences hosts the CCIS Innovation Center which is distinguished by the latest technologies and devices such as robots, 3D printers and virtual reality devices in a way that supports the quality of the educational process and supports innovative ideas and projects to be a gateway and an important tributary to achieve the goals of the university within the strategic orientations, innovative technologies, and local and global trends in Entrepreneurship in the field of specialization.

With what the university possesses, and the achievements and distinctions it has achieved in e-learning, the university was chosen among five local universities to offer distance education-style programs. The university has also attracted leading companies, to be an option for it. In the year 1442 AH, the first Apple Developer Academy for women developers in the Middle East was founded in the university to achieve leadership in the digital sector and application programming, Qualifying female entrepreneurs, developers and specialists in the field.

The College of Business Administration provides its students with a share hall that was established under the auspices of the Saudi Stock Exchange Company "Tadawul" and specialized laboratories with the aim of preparing female graduates for the labor market in a way that supports the knowledge-based economy and ensures the highest qualification for the use of modern technologies and software required by the labor market.

The university is strengthening its role in supporting academic, scientific and research excellence, through an integrated system for research, innovation and entrepreneurship at the level of initiatives and even access to patents, with the required supportive partnerships with various parties.

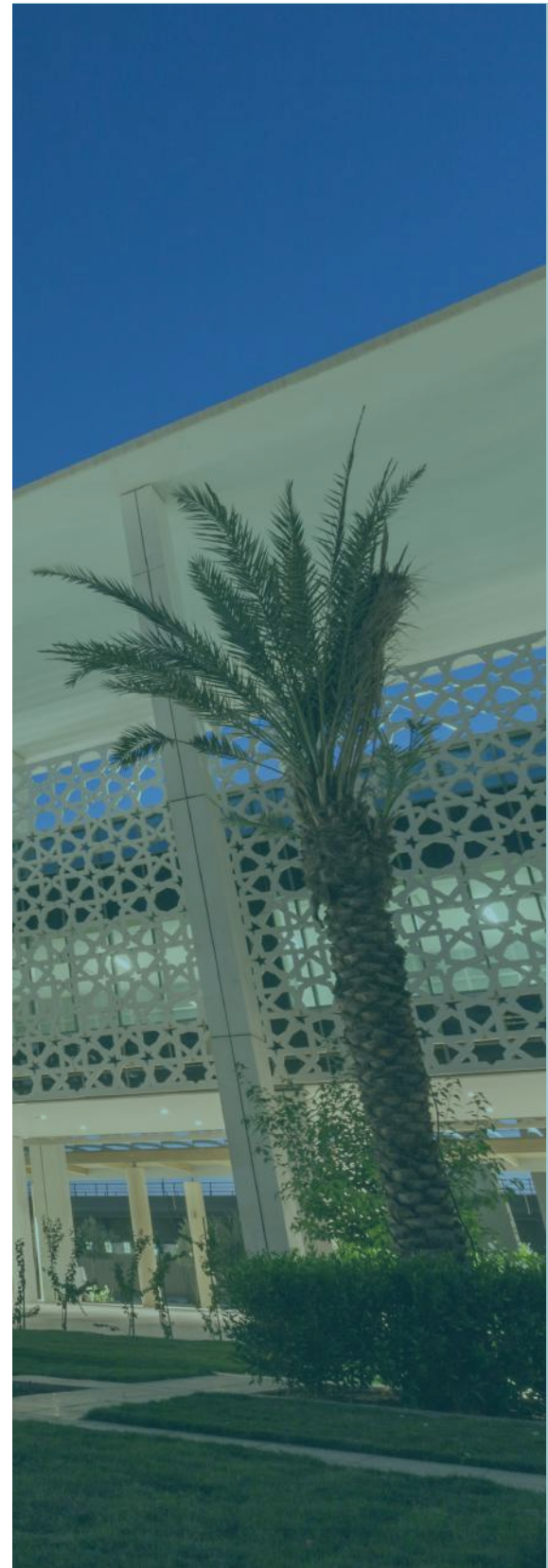

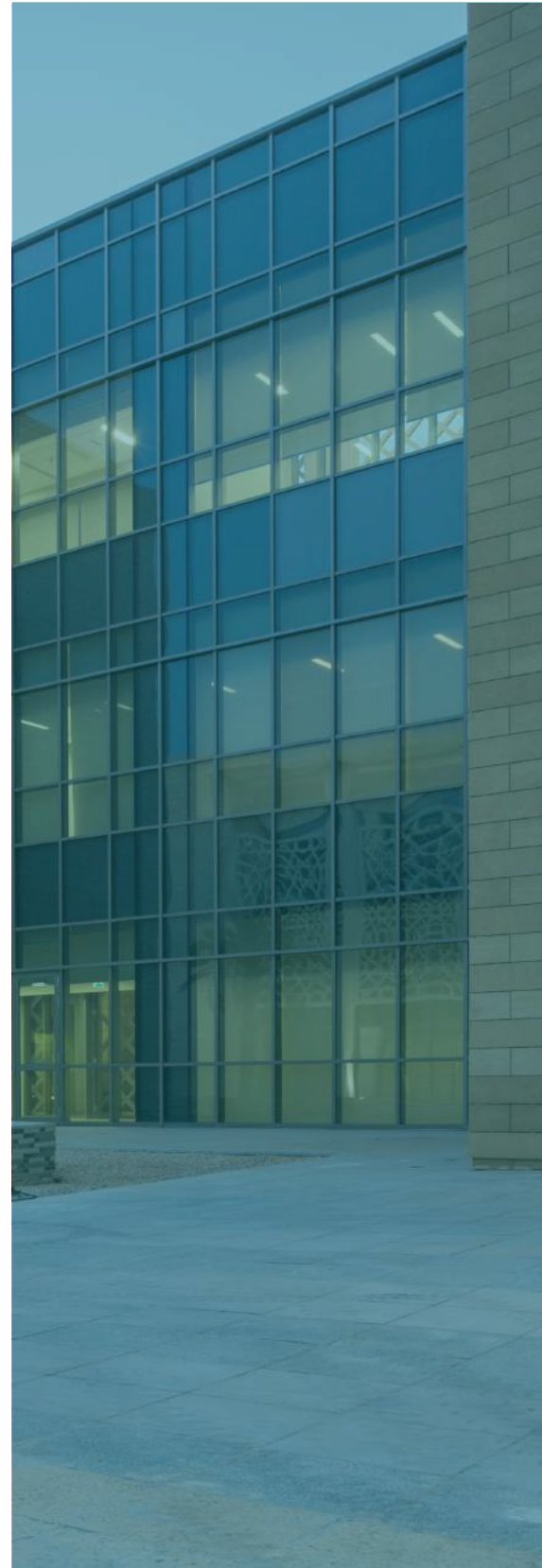

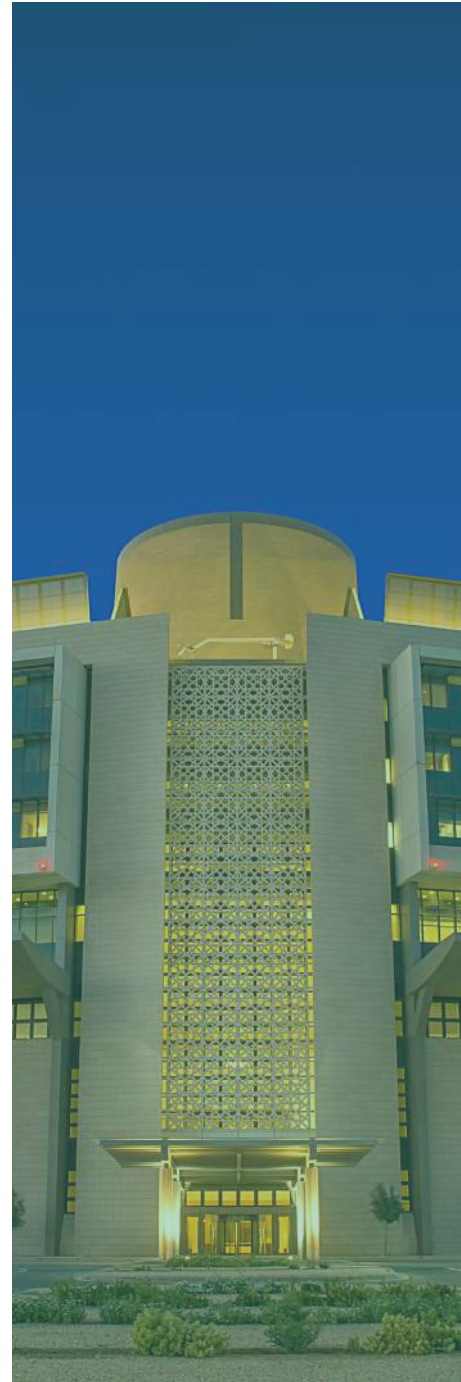

# Health Programs

The university offers a number of programs in health specializations, which are offered by the College of Nursing, College of Rehabilitation and Health Sciences and the College of Pharmacy. Some of these programs are offered in local and global partnerships, giving students the opportunity to obtain global scientific and research experiences within a local environment. These programs are also offered with the support of the university's partnerships with a number of government and private health sectors and non-profit institutions. The health community, which is compatible with the quality of life program in the Kingdom's 2030 Vision, is one of the strategic orientations of the university, which it has given great attention by establishing a community health system in which all university sectors are integrated, which represents qualitative support for programs with competitive advantages that the university possesses in the field of health specialties.

## King Abdullah bin Abdulaziz University Hospital (KAAUH)

An equipped teaching hospital with a capacity of 300 beds, including outpatient clinics, inpatient rooms, and an ambulance and emergency department. The hospital is distinguished by the presence of three integrated centers of excellence in specialties: women's health, adolescent health, and child growth and development, in addition to the presence of specialized clinics. The hospital operates with the highest local, regional and global standards, To achieve the highest levels of quality at work, by obtaining many accreditations and certificates from the competent authorities. As part of the hospital's mission, it is based on integrating the services provided with education and research, in a way that enhances experiences and skills to reach the best knowledge and care for patients and students using the latest tools.

## Simulation and Skills Development

The Simulation and Clinical Skills Development Center at Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University is one of the largest simulation centers in the world, and it was equipped with the latest medical equipment and highly qualified human cadres to enhance the educational and scientific process in the health field. The center works to keep pace with the rapid developments and changes in simulation-based education in health care, and to improve the quality of Healthcare practices and clinical skills development. The center also offers courses in continuing professional education, in addition to training and evaluating health practitioners in cooperation with the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties. The simulation center has obtained total accreditation from the American Society of Medical Simulation, which is the highest institutional accreditation granted to simulation centers in the world, and the American Society of Medical Simulation is the internationally recognized regional and international reference for medical simulation education centers.

## Health Sciences Research Center

The center provides opportunities for scientific research for university employees and researchers from graduate students and collaborating bodies. The center includes 30 laboratories, of which 18 are in basic sciences. Biology laboratories are having a tissue culture room for each laboratory, which makes them unique in the world. The center also includes a specialized database and 20 animal incubators with all their requirements, including operating rooms, sterilization, and so on. The center provides research lab services using the latest equipment and advanced analytical methods. The services include various disciplines such as genomics, biotechnology and analytical chemistry.

## Lifestyle and Health Research Center

It is the first center in the region that specializes in lifestyle behaviors and health, with a focus on the health of children, adolescents and women. The center is equipped with the most modern and advanced equipment from laboratories and offices for research and statistical analysis.

## International accreditation of the university from the World Health Organization

Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University obtained international accreditation as the first Saudi and Arab **university city to promote health** in the countries of the region. We obtained the accreditation of The World Health Organization (WHO) for its six tracks, comprising 102 standards. It deals with health, social and environmental aspects.

## Health professions license exams

For several years, Princess Nourah University students achieved **advanced positions** in the results of the Saudi tests for licenses to practice health professions from the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties, thus achieving integration with the most competitive market.

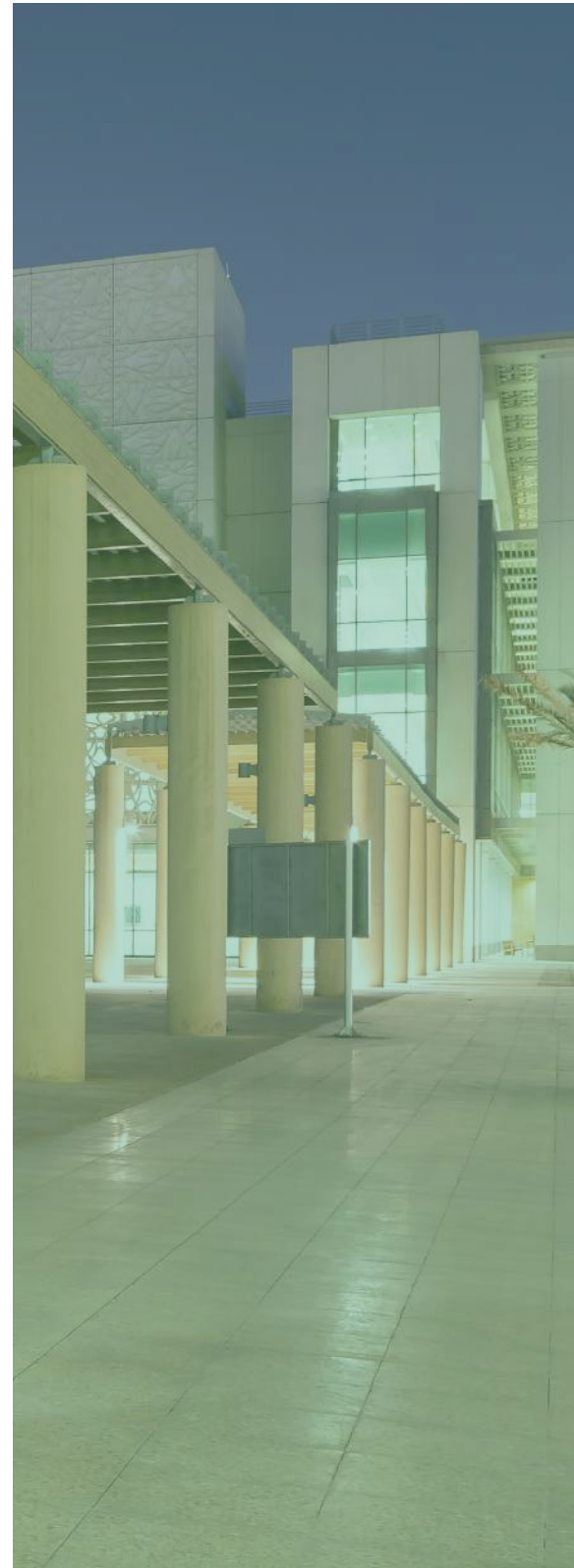

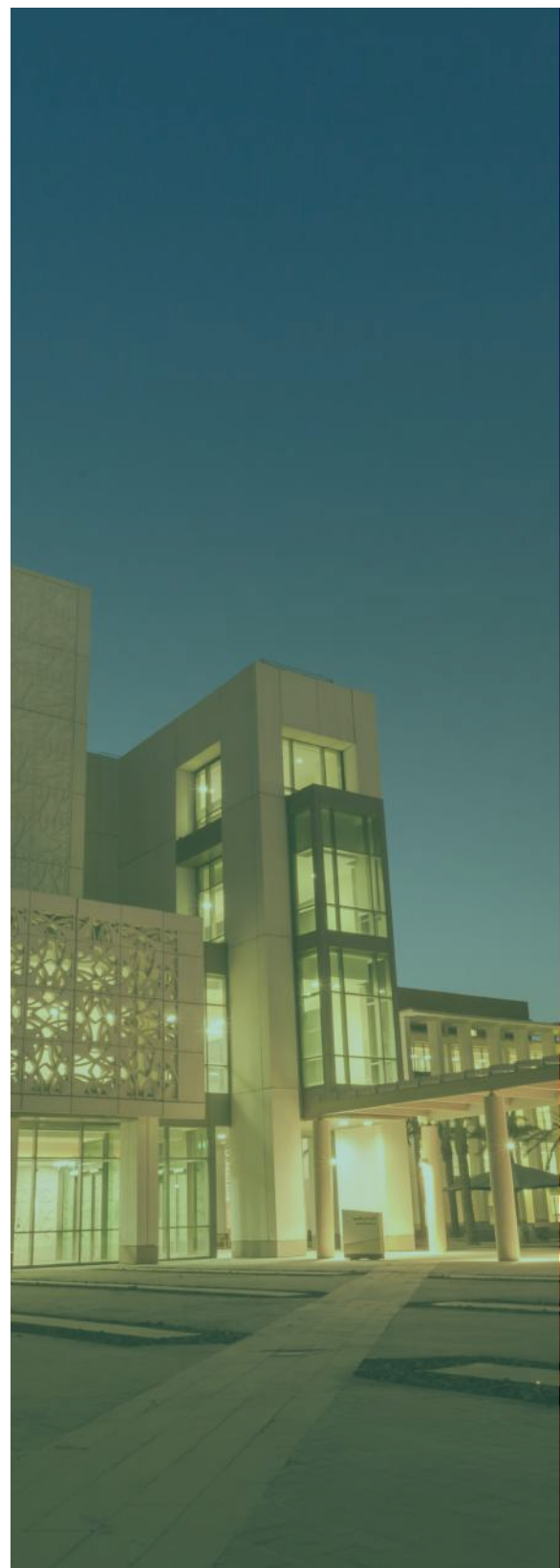

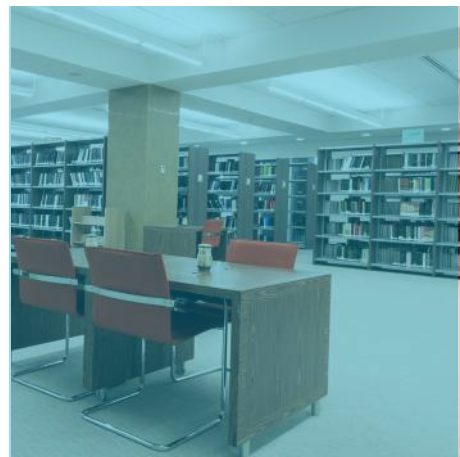

# Humanities Programs

The university offers a number of specialized programs that keep up with the changes and meet the needs of society and the requirements of national development in integration and cooperation with the various academic and professional sectors and bodies inside and outside of the university. The university, through its faculties and specialized programs, seeks to keep up with modern trends in educational practices and policies, towards improving and creating the applied environment for building educational and professional experiences, and creating appropriate opportunities to invest in capabilities and enhance the capabilities of female cadres. The provision of these programs supports qualitative capabilities with competitive advantages that the university possesses within a distinguished educational environment in the field of humanities.

The College of Education is the first host of female teachers in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. It was founded in 1390 AH / 1970 AD as the first educational college for girls in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The College plays an important and fundamental role in the educational field, in line with the changes to provide quality programs that meet local needs and in accordance with international trends and practices. The college includes Nourah Houses for Educational Experience: the Consultation and Professional Development House, the Digital House, and the Talent House. The Houses of Expertise aim to transform knowledge and science into services and products by investing expertise, providing advisory services, and finding opportunities to develop the talents and skills of technical and creative students.

The College of Education and Human Development supervises full academic and administrative supervision of the Watan Nursery in the University Campus, with the educational and professional expertise that the College possesses in the educational field. The nursery is run by distinguished Saudi cadres trained to deal with the early childhood stage to provide comprehensive care and learning for the child by developing him healthily, cognitively and socially in a safe environment that conforms to international standards.

The College of Humanities and Social Sciences , with its expertise since the year 1399 AH / 1400 AH, offers a number of specialized academic programs. The college reflects a cultural dimension through the Historical Museum, which displays models that simulate the antiquities and heritage of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, and presents human civilizations and historical events, which were established on the land of the Arabian Peninsula, using the idea of chronological historical hierarchy from the earliest times through the Islamic period to our modern era and the Saudi era. 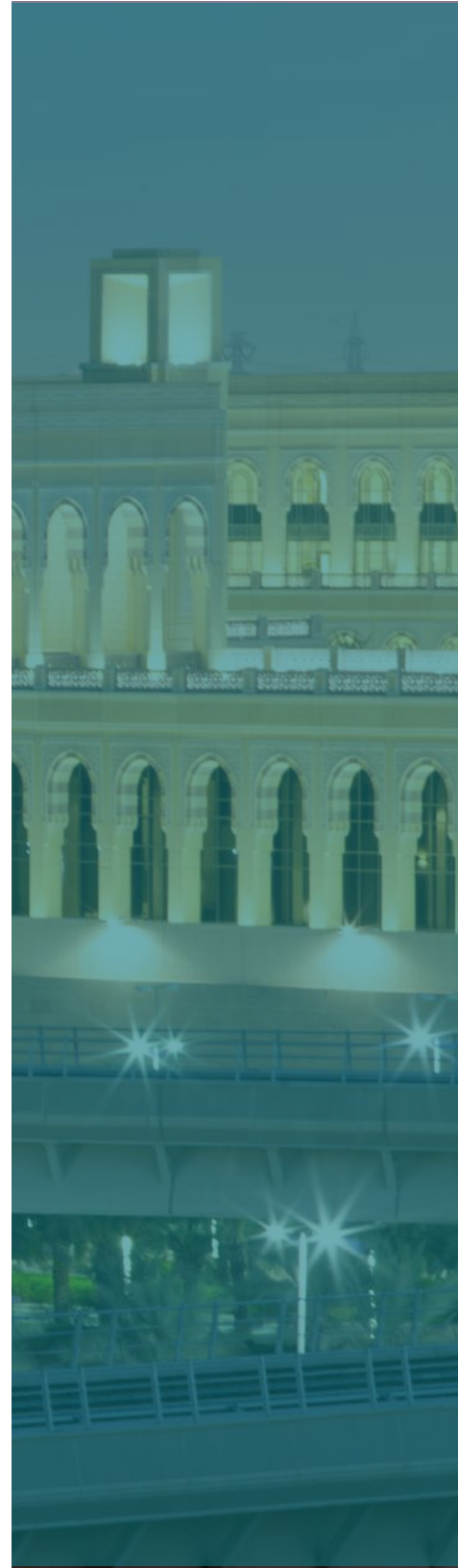


# Supporting Services and University Facilities

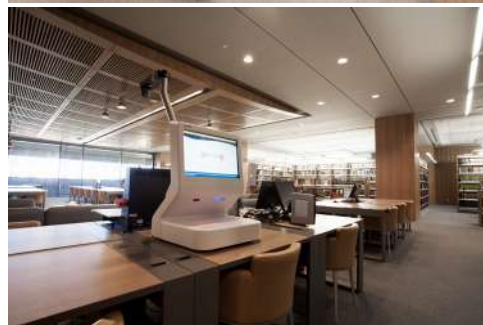

# Health Services

Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University seeks to activate the quality of life program, which is one of the programs of the Kingdom's Vision 2030, and has made the university one of its strategic directions a healthy society. The achievement of this directive is supported by the existence of an integrated system of health colleges, facilities and services that enhance this, the most important of which is the presence of King Abdullah Hospital, in addition to the Simulation and Skills Development Center, the Health Sciences Research Center, the Lifestyle and Health Research Center, the Family Counseling Center (Tarabut), and the Nourah Health Program..

## King Abdullah University Hospital (KAAUH)

An equipped educational hospital with a capacity of (300) beds and includes outpatient clinics, inpatient rooms, as well as an ambulance and emergency department, in addition to specialized clinics that provide services in the following specialties:

Obstetrics, gynecology, internal medicine, surgery, pediatrics, ENT, ophthalmology and urology. In addition, the hospital is distinguished by the presence of three integrated centers of excellence in the following specialties:

- Women's Health
- Adolescent Health
- Child's growth and development

As part of its mission, the hospital is based on integrating the services provided with education and research in order to reach the best knowledge and care for patients and students using the latest methods, and adopting the best methods to provide safe and high quality care.

## Dental clinics

Dental clinics at Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University are managed by a comprehensive clinic management system which is a program designed exclusively for academic use in dentistry and from (Axiom) among its functions is scheduling appointments, billing patients, instrument tracking, student evaluation, and planning, which is an archiving system for therapeutic radiology. (MiPacs) in addition to the digital x-ray software that was designed as a central stock of radiology images]

The clinics of the College of Dentistry include several departments: sterilization department, radiology, dental implant clinic, dental clinic anesthesia department, dental clinic lab, department of appointments and medical records, emergency clinic, and undergraduate clinics, which are educational clinics for students of the College of Dentistry in which patients are cared for and treated under the supervision of faculty members using the latest advanced equipment.

## Simulation and Skills Development Center

The Center for Simulation and Skills Development is accredited by several bodies, the American Society for Health Simulation, the American Heart Association, the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties and the Saudi Neonatal Society.

The center works on the development of clinical skills and training based on the simulation of the development of the merits of the health college students at the Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University and the employees of the King Abdullah Bin Abdel -Aziz University, in addition to the generalization of the general cord. The center offers a standard patient program to simulate the reality of the real patient, thus contributing to the development of professionals in the medical fields. The Life Support Center at the Simulation and Skill Development Center also offers a range of American Heart Association-authorized life support courses such as the BLS Course and Basic Life Support Skills. The Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) course, the cardiac arrest course and the HSFA first aid course for healthcare workers. The center also provides training courses for community members through periodic training visits to schools, colleges and communities in an initiative to raise health awareness of first aid and training on cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

## Health Sciences Research Center

The Health Sciences Research Center is one of several research centers at Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University. The center is located in the middle of the five health colleges at the University, and near the University hospital. The center aims to enhance the level of scientific research through research projects and programs to support and develop the quality of scientific research for students and employees of the University and its cooperating bodies. It devotes efforts to pursuing and supporting the goals of scientific research to improve health, prevent and treat disease, and understand human and animal functions. The center contains 36 laboratories, including 18 biology laboratories, 12 chemistry laboratories, 4 physics laboratories, 1 dry laboratory, and two laboratories designated for the Lifestyle and Health Research Center. The biology laboratories feature a Tissue Cultivation room for each laboratory, which makes it unique in the world. It also contains a database center and 20 animal incubators with supplies such as operation rooms, sterilization, etc.

# Health Services

## Lifestyle and Health Research Center

It is the first center in the region to specialize in lifestyle behaviors and health, with a focus on the health of children, adolescents and women. The center is equipped with the latest modern and advanced equipment in specialized laboratories and offices for research and statistical analysis.

## Nourah's Health Program

A program that cares about the health of the community of Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University with the concept of comprehensive health with its three axes (psychological, social, and organic) by motivating and motivating the university community in various disciplines, faculties and departments to participate in improving the health of students and university employees. The program works to build a leading model among all universities in Saudi Arabia, towards a supportive university environment that is concerned with the general health of female students in addition to their academic pathway. In the year 2021, Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University obtained international accreditation from the World Health Organization as the first Saudi and Arab university city to promote health in the countries of the region. The accreditation of the International Health Promoting University was obtained with its six tracks, consisting of 102 standards concerned with health, social and environmental aspects.

## Family Counseling Center

The first center specialized in the family among universities in the Kingdom. This center was established to participate in addressing family problems that threaten the security and cohesion of the family, and to correct some concepts related to the family, marriage, energy, procreation, and the foundations of sound education. The center offers psychological counseling sessions through the phone by a selection of psychological and social specialists. The center also provides training courses and awareness brochures in its field of specialization. The center is supervised by a number of specialists in the field of social work, psychology and administration, and provides its services to university employees and the outside community. Realizing the importance of family cohesion and bonding and its impact on the interconnectedness and unity of society, Princess Nourah bint Abdulrahman University adopted the establishment of the Family Counseling Center, believing in its role in community service, under the slogan:

**"Close-knit family, Safe community"**

## Student Support and Services Center (A4 )

## Community Service

### Nourah Al Ataa Volunteer Initiative

The Nourah Al Ataa Volunteer Initiative aims to spread the culture of sustainable national volunteer work as a system, and transfer it from traditional initiatives to professional work., in addition to strengthening the role of national volunteer work in the comprehensive development of society in partnership with leading voluntary bodies and associations, and organizing the utilization of energies and human resources inside and outside the university through preparing and qualifying them for national volunteer work, and graduating volunteers Holders of a volunteer work license, and documentation of the license hours on the National Volunteer Work Platform of the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Development.

### Nourah Al Ataa platform for community service

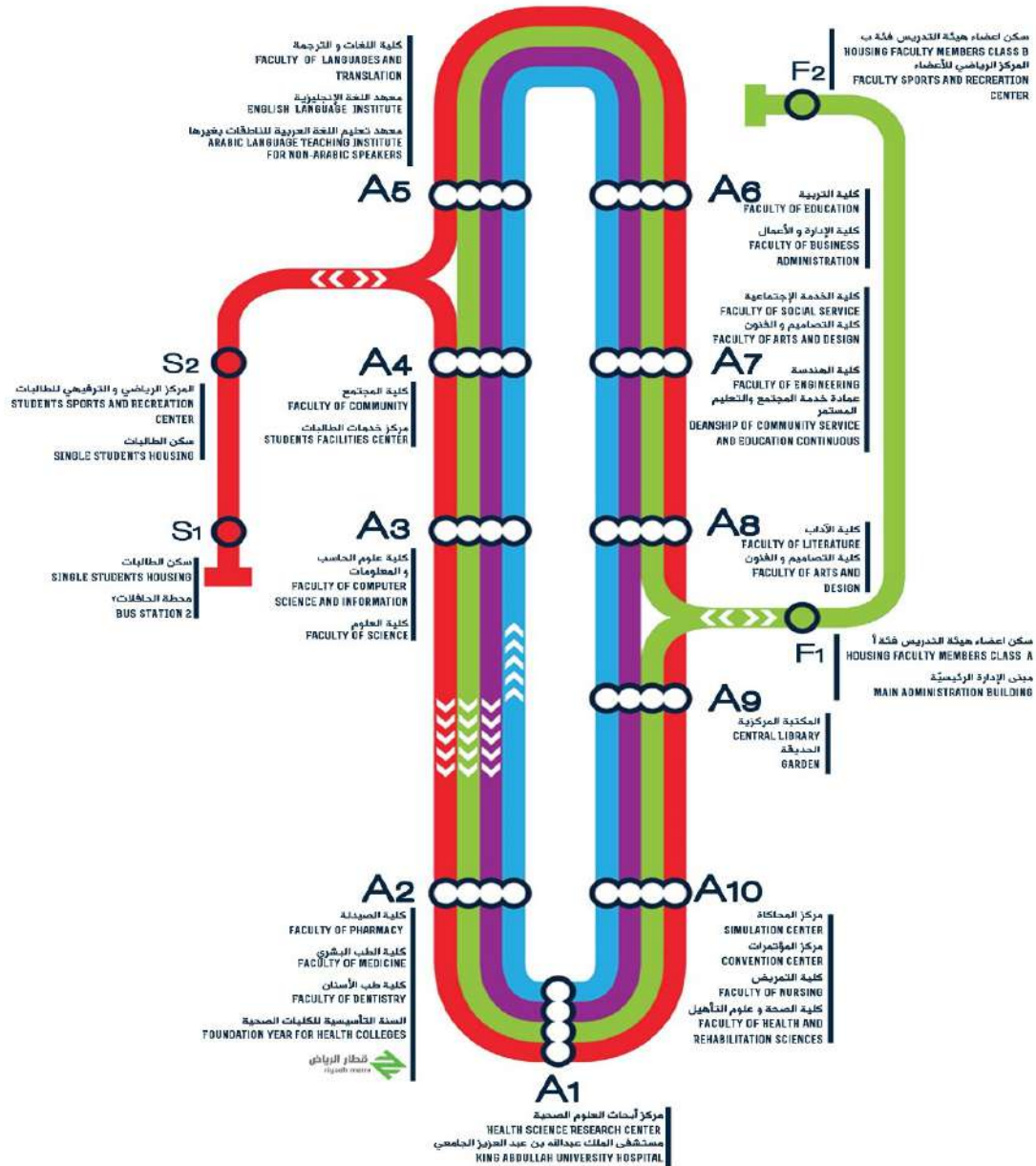
